2003 Grand National Go-Ped Championships:

All Go-Ped participants must become a IGPA member. A 1 day Membership is available for a \$15.00 fee. A Yearly Membership is available for \$45.00 that includes a T-Shirt, and Racing Number Plate. Go-Ped Entry Fee's are \$30.00 for the 1st class, and \$25.00 for each additional Class. The Pee Wee non-motorized Class is \$5.00.

Bring a Friend:

We are offering a "Bring a Friend" Program at all Events. If you bring a friend who has never raced before, both the New Rider, and the person who is responsible for bringing them to the races will both receive 1 Free Salom each that may be used at that Event. The person who brings a friend will receive 1 Salom credit, and the New Rider will also receive 1 Salom credit. The New Rider must never have raced before, and not have a IJSBA membership to qualify. The New Rider may apply for a 1 day membership or sign up for a Yearly IJSBA Membership at that Event.

Double Round Rider Discounts:

The 2003 U.S. Grand National Watercross Championships will be offering a Rider Discount for our Double Round Events. The Rider Discount will be used for Rounds 1 through Round 4. If a Rider signs up for to race a particular Class on both Saturday, and Sunday, then the Rider will receive a \$10.00 Discount per Class the 2nd Day (Sunday). The Rider will be required to have signed up for the same classes on Saturday, as well as Sunday. For example, if a Rider signs up for 3 Classes on Saturday, they must sign up for those same exact classes on Sunday to get the \$10.00 Rider Discount (which would amount to a \$30.00 savings). A Rider who doesn't race on Saturday, but signs up to race on Sunday will NOT be eligible for any Rider Discount that weekend. This does not apply to Salom Classes.

Vintage Racing:

Round 5	Harbor Beach - All Novice Classes, and all Can-Am Events will run on Saturday. All Expert Classes will run on Sunday.
Round 6	Nashville, TN - All Novice Classes will run on Saturday. All Amateur, and Expert Classes run on Sunday.
